



Emergency Contraception



Emergency contraception is used by women to stop them getting pregnant.



A woman may want emergency contraception if she has had sex without using any contraception.



There are two main kinds of emergency contraception

120

The emergency contraceptive pill which has to be taken within 120 hours of having sex without contraception.



Or

The coil or IUD

The coil or IUD can be fitted up to 5 days after having sex without contraception
