

The Contraceptive Implant



The contraceptive implant is a small flexible rod put under the skin of the upper arm
It releases the hormone progestogen



It is over 99% effective at preventing pregnancy



It works for 3 years



Side effects

Periods may stop, be irregular or longer
Some women may get spots
Some women report having mood changes and breast tenderness



Other Comments

It requires a small procedure to put in and take out the implant from your upper arm.



Some other medicines may effect how the implant works.
